

SUMMER SEMINAR
TERMS AND CONDITIONS

§ 1.

1. The present Terms and Conditions specify the rules and the course of the Summer Seminar.
2. The Summer Seminar is organised by Centre for Political Thought, henceforth, "the Organiser."
3. The Summer Seminar takes place between 24 and 29 August 2014 in Krakow (Poland).
4. The purpose of the Summer Seminar is to promote Polish history among foreign teachers.
5. The programme includes lectures by prominent Polish scientists and Polish history experts, a workshop, and visits to the Polish memorials and the monuments of Polish culture.

§ 2.

1. The Organiser covers the costs of accommodation, transport inside the country, board, promotional materials and the attractions of the programme.
2. The Participants buy the tickets to Poland and back themselves, up to the cost of 120 GBP. The money will be given back to them when they present their tickets.
3. The Participants are obliged to obtain insurance and to cover the costs of international travels from their own means.

§ 3.

1. In order to become a Participant of the Summer Seminar a person must be a foreign teacher. Full-time as well as part-time teachers are eligible to apply.
2. The Participants are obliged to participate actively in the classes and events included in the programme.
3. Every Participant is obliged to arrive on time in places indicated in the programme.
4. Resignation from participation in classes after the programme has started involves reimbursing the entire cost of organising the course for one person.

§ 4.

1. The Organiser does not bear responsibility for the damage done by the Participants in the place of accommodation or stay.
2. The Organiser reserves the right to remove a Participant from the course in the case of unjustified lack of participation in the classes of the programme, as well as in cases of egregious violation of the rules of social interactions.

§ 5.

1. Personal data of the Participants shall be collected in the Organiser's databases. The set of data that are collected and processed is protected in accordance with Polish law, namely the Act of August 29, 1997: Personal Data Protection Act (Journal of Laws No. 101 of 2002, Item 926, as amended) [ustawa z dnia 29 sierpnia 1997r. o ochronie danych osobowych (Dz. U. Nr 101 z 2002 r., poz.926, z późn. zm.).

2. Every Participant consents to collecting and processing the abovementioned personal data by the Organiser.

§ 6.

1. Doubts and questions resulting from adhering to the present Terms and Conditions and issues unregulated by the present Terms and Conditions shall be settled individually by the Organiser of the Summer Seminar.

2. The Terms and Conditions enter into force on 1 May 2014.
